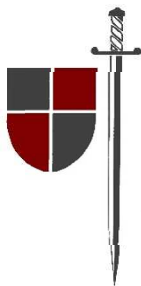
Daylight Saving Time Ends – This Saturday evening, Nov. 3rd, set your clocks back 1 hour.
